
























Firefighter Time #1

Dramatic PLAY



You will need:

- Fire Station Banner
- Dramatic Play props (eg, uniform, hat, phone, printer, notepad, pretend tools, fire truck toys).
 - Table and chairs
 - Outdoor space
 - Pretend hose, trucks etc

METHOD

- Design a Fire Station using the suggested materials above.
- 2. Print and make the dramatic play prop using the notepad printable below.
- 3. Set up a Fire Station for play. Place prop printables on the table.
- 4. Engage in pretend play, pretending to leave the station and go in the yard to attend jobs, take calls inside the station and return to the station to clean up.

Adult Supervision is required at all times.

You will need:

- Magnetic Tiles (we love Connetix Tiles)
- Landscape pieces (nature or blocks or table runners, or placemats or silks or loose parts eg, manadala pieces (ours are from Busy Little Bundles)
 - Road set up (we recommend Ways to Play sets as they are what we use — from The Creative Toyshop)
 - Toy Fire trucks/Cars
 - Soft Toys
 - Flat Surface

METHOD (together or Invitation to PLAY)

Set up cars with their owners (soft toys) on the road and the fire truck + firefighter helping the owners with their cars. Build city/town landscape with magnetic tiles and landscape with pieces, silks and loose parts.

OPTIONAL — Use the notepad to take down notes about the situation.


2. Dramatise firefighters helping the car owners (community members) who are experiencing difficulties or accidents with their cars.

Refer to the investigation question — How can I explore the role of a firefighter and how they serve the community through PLAY?

Adult Supervision is required at all times.



You will need

- Fire Trucks
 - Paint
- Paper (large)
- Drying space

METHOD

- Squeeze a dollop of paint in various colours on a piece of paper
- 2. Hold Fire Truck and run them through the paint.

 Making track marks.
- 3. Look at each track carefully and describe what it looks like eg, thin, thick, round, straight etc
 - 4. After artwork is complete, leave it to dry.
 - 5. Hang up artwork in the Fire Station
 - 6. Place fire trucks in the sink for a sensory play experience see PLAY IDEA #5 (bonus idea below)

Refer to the investigation question — How can I explore the role of a firefighter and how they serve the community through PLAY?

Adult Supervision is required at all times.

You will need:

- Fire Truck Printable (see below)
- Red, Blue and Black crepe paper squares (size depends on your little learner's fine motor skills)
 - Trays/baskets
 - Glue


METHOD


- 1. Cut up crepe paper into squares.
- 2. Scrunch crepe paper into balls and place them in a basket (separate colours).
 - 3. Print the fire truck printable.
 - 4. Paste the crepe paper balls onto the fire truck.
 - 5. Repeat until the truck is covered.
 - 6. Enjoy and take photos to hang up in the Fire Station.
- 5. Refer to the investigation question How can I explore the role of a firefighter and how they serve the community through PLAY?

Adult Supervision is required at all times.
