In this resource you will find:


- 1 x Dramatic PLAY Idea







Print on coloured cardstock to create your very own coloured letters to use as a banner.




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



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You will need:

- Soft Toys (animals)
- 'Cardboard boxes or cardboard DIY fences
 - Toy Kitchen
 - Tickets
 - Food Bowls with pretend food

METHOD

- 1. Set up the toy kitchen with Zoo Time banner.
- 2. Set up the soft toy in pretend enclosures as if they are attending a tea party.
- 3. Add word cards to display on zoo walls or on the ticket table.
 - 4. Take on the role as zookeeper and feed the animals.
 - 5. Place the food onto their plates.
 - 6. Take photos as a keepsake!
- 7. OPTIONAL Take on the role as the ticket collector too.

Dramatic PLAY Centre Idea

You will need:

- Lion Template
- Crepe paper or alternative
 - Glue
 - Scissors
 - Markers

METHOD


- 1. Print the lion template from the next page.
- 2. Cut up crepe paper into squares using various colours. If you don't have crepe paper, other items such as tissue paper, newspaper, magazines can all be used instead.
 - 3. Roll up the squares to make balls.
- 4. Paste the balls onto the lion template until it is covered.

MODIFICATION IDEA — colour some of the lion with a marker and collage the rest.


Zoo Time #2

Craft Idea





Print onto cardstock and collage using various craft supplies eg, crepe paper, tissue paper, magazine pages or newspaper.



You will need:

- A tub or tray
- Sensory Base eg. playdough or soup beans
 - Landscape pieces
 - Dear Zoo picture book
 - Animal figurines

METHOD

- 1. Place the sensory base in the base of the tray or tub.
- 2. Set animal figurines and landscape pieces in the tray or tub.
- B. Read the book and place it on display with the small world, so it can be accessed during play.
 - 4. OPTIONAL Add scoops and containers 5. Enjoy!!

An Art Idea


You will need:


- Giraffe template (next slide)
 - Dot paint stampers

METHOD

- 1. Colour the parts of the giraffe that you prefer to have coloured.
 - 2. Paint the dot stampers on the giraffe's spots.
- 3. Let it dry and hang up in the Zoo Dramatic Play Centre.

EXTENSION IDEA — Colour spots with oil pastels and watercolour paint the rest of the giraffe's body.

Fine Motor PLAY Idea




You will need:

- Lion template
- Coloured paper strips
 - Pencils
 - Glue
 - Scissors

METHOD

- 1. Colour and cut out the lion template.
- 2. Cut the coloured paper into strips.
- 3. Roll the strips around a pencil to curl it.
- 4. Glue the strips around the mane of the lion's face.
- 5. Let the mane dry and hang the art up in the dramatic play centre.
