day of the week	rlsources needed
1	Pull out the watercolour paints and paint onto paper. Have some paper
	towels and wipes on hand for any spills. Watch your little one paint.
2	Cut string into small lengths $-$ (10-20cms long). Deem what size is safe for
	your little learners. Tie a big knot at one end to stop the pasta from falling
	off. Thread the pasta onto the string.
3	Use coloured paperclips to match to shapes with the same colour as the
	paperclip. Shape Mats are in the PLAY portal.
4	Find resources listed in the resource list. Set each different activity up in a
	rotation. Move your way through each rotation. EXTENSION — take score and
	have a medal presentation at the end and/or have an opening and closing
	ceremony.
5	Pop on your favourite tunes and dance away
6	Bring out your favourite books and read together.
7	Set up a small world invitation with wild animal figurines. Watch your little
	one play.
8	Set up hopscotch outside or inside and play. You could use chalk or a store
0	bought hopscotch mat.
9	Collect ingredients listed in the resource list. Follow this link for the
10	Layered Liquids recipe and scientific explanation. Roll out a large piece of paper and write your child's name on it. Set up
10	glue and natural pieces to glue on over each letter of the name. EXTENSION
	- Encourage correct letter direction.
11	Source some letter cards (some in the play portal) and print. Hide these
	cards throughout the house and go on a scavenger hunt to find them.
	EXTENSION — say the letter name, phoneme and match it to an object in the
	home starting with the same letter.
12	Collect or buy rocks (we love the Tuscan path stones from Bunnings) and
	add them to some markers and paper towel on a flat surface. Draw onto the
	stones. If you would like to keep these grab some sealer (we use Boyle's
	matt spray from Spotlight) to seal them.
13	Source ping pong balls and write numbers on them and print out a set of
	numeral cards (in the play portal). Match the ping pong ball to the numeral
	card.
14	Find ingredients. Roll the playdough into 5-6 balls. Then flatten them slightly
	and line them up in a row. Stand apiece of spaghetti upright using the
	playdough ball as a holder for the spaghetti. Then watch your little one
	thread the pasta (I recommend penne or rigatoni) onto the spaghetti.
15	Invite your little one to join you with the housework chores.

16	Set up a game of quoits (store bought or DIY) and play together.		
17	Set up the ABC Listen podcast on your device and listen to a podcast. Chat		
	about what each of you heard and your favourite part.		
18	Bring out the collection of magnetic tiles. We love and support Connetix tiles		
	as we are a brand rep.		
19	Print out the colour mats (in the PLAY portal) and match toys to the colours.		
20	Set up a table cubby using furniture and blankets.		
21	Set up your favourite foods, rug and head outdoors to eat and play.		
22	Use the puppet stand made from previous weeks, add some puppets to the		
	puppet theatre and begin to create your very own puppet show.		
23	Set up a tub with a small amount of water. Add dishwashing liquid, a sponge		
	and dolls. Wash the dolls and dry them.		
24	Fill up the watering can and water the plants.		
2.5	Look through the photo album and talk about the people and places in the		
	album.		
26	Add some books to the puppet stand and read them with the puppets.
